

## Guidelines for self-organised, school-based visits abroad

- 1. Our school supports and promotes study visits abroad by our learners, especially in Germany.
  - The application should contain information about the date, duration, location, school, contact person and motivation for the visit.
- 2. The visit abroad should take place during our school holidays if possible.
- 3. The application for leave of absence for a study visit abroad should be made timeously via the class teacher to school management.
- 4. The following documents from the host school must be submitted to the DSJ after the school attendance:
  - A short report about the learner's behaviour
  - If applicable, a list of the individual marks achieved
  - School attendance certificate
- 5. The learner is responsible for catching up on missed school work.
- The DSJ will use its pedagogical discretion to grand a grace / catch-up period until the marks / performance assessments (verbal or written) are due.
  As a rule, this period comprises 7 days for up to three missed school weeks and 14 days for a longer exchange visit.
- 7. Marks achieved at the host school are not included in the marks at the DSJ.
